Consultancy: Evaluation of overall policy coherence and recommendations for designing and implementing an optimal policy package for Measuring, Reporting and Verification (MRV), Sri Lanka Carbon Registry (SLCR) and Sri Lanka Carbon Crediting Scheme (SLCCS)

The Climate Mitigation Action Support Project intends to call Expression of Interest (EOI) from qualified and interested consultancy firms for the above consultancy.

This consultancy is procured under the CMASP which is a grant (No. TF0B0017) of the Partnership for Market Readiness (PMR) Secretariat under the World Bank.

The consultancy expects to assess existing policies related to climate change mitigation, identify needs for strengthening them, recommend any new regulations and/or policies, evaluate the interactions between new and existing measures in order to understand the coherence of the overall climate policy mix, provide an optimal policy package recommendations with a roadmap for implementation which would potentially include relevant complementary policies for the SLCCS, MRV and SLCR to meet the country's development goals as well as Nationally Determined Contributions implementation. The period of the consultancy service is six (6) months.

The Ministry Consultant Procurement Committee on behalf of the Climate Mitigation Action Support Project now invites eligible consultancy firms to express their interest in providing the services described herein. Interested consultancy firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified and experienced to perform the aforementioned consultancy.

EOI should include the following information relevant to the consultancy:

- Experience of the firm and team of experts in policy analysis and design at national level or sectoral level in relation to climate change
- Academic/professional qualifications of team of experts in policy analysis, economics, energy, transport, industry, waste and AFOLU (Agriculture, Forestry and Other Land Use) sectors
- Profile of the consultancy firm including scope of the services/business, legal status, administrative and financial capacity, etc.,

(Team of expert should submit resumes with their experience, academic/professional qualifications and other supportive information fulfilling the requirement given in the ToR)

Consultants will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Guidelines for Selection and Employment of Consultants, published by the National Procurement Agency following Selection of Consultant's Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method.
